CSR 911 is the 24 hour 911 Dispatch Center proudly Serving the 125,000+ residents who call Snyder, Union, and Upper Northumberland Counties their home.

12 Law Enforcement Agencies, 24 Fire Departments, and 25 EMS agencies, as well as, 29 Townships, 13 Boros, and various county agencies rely on services from the 911 Operations Center and the Emergency Telecommunicators.

The Operations Center is staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year.



Text to 9-1-1

Call If You Can, Text When You Can't

The best & most efficient way to establish a quicker emergency response is to call 9-1-1.

A voice call to 911 is far better than texting, because if additional information is needed, you are able to provide it freely vs. the time it takes to text. Calling from a landline or cell phone will also help provide 9-1-1 with your location. Voice Communication is best whenever possible.

Texting 9-1-1 Facts

You must have a text capable wireless phone & wireless service plan. You cannot text 911 without a phone text service plan.

Message applications do not work with 911

Text emergencies only

Do not send photos and videos

Do no abbreviate words or use emojis

Example: 55 year old male having chest pain need an ambulance at 222 Cannon Run Road, Name of Borough or Township

Do not Group Text when texting 911

Texting 9-1-1 can be delayed a few seconds

When should you text to 911?

- Domestic violence situations
- Home invasions
- Abductions
- If unable to speak or hear due to disability or injury
- If a voice call to 911 puts you in a dangerous situation
