ORDINANCE NO. 7.17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TURBOTVILLE, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 88-4 PERTAINING TO THE RESTRICTIONS OF CERTAIN VEHICLES AND REFUSE DUMPTERS IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS AND ON STREETS, ALLEYS, HIGHWAYS, ROADWAYS, OR WAYS IN THE BOROUGH OF TURBOTVILLE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THERETO

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Turbotville, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section III.B. of Ordinance No. 88-4, as enacted by Ordinance No. 4-17 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section III.B.: It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be parked on any of the streets, alleys, highways, roadways or ways within the Borough of Turbotville without a valid vehicle license and a current inspection sticker, both of which shall be displayed on the vehicle at all times when it is so parked as aforesaid.

SECTION 2. Section IV, Penalties, of Ordinance No. 88-4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Penalties for Parking Violations — Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding before a District Justice be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$75.00 for each offense and in default of such payment, such person shall be imprisoned for a period not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation is continued shall constitute a separate offense. It shall be the duty of the Parking Enforcement Personnel designated by the Borough Council of the Borough of Turbotville, pursuant to this Ordinance, to report to the appropriate official violations of any provision of this Article, and indicating in each case: the section violated; the license number of the vehicle involved in the violation; the location the violation took place; and other facts that may be necessary in order to secure a clear understanding of the circumstances pertaining to the violation.

The Parking Enforcement Personnel may also attach to or place upon every such vehicle a notice (ticket) stating that the vehicle was parked in violation of the Article. In addition, it shall contain instructions to the operator of the vehicle that if they will deliver the notice (ticket) to the Borough Offices of the Borough of Turbotville

during the times indicated or mail the same by regular U.S. Mail and pay the sum of \$15.00 within ten (10) days after the time of the notice, this will save the violator from additional penalties and/or prosecution. Failure of any owner or operator to pay the sum of \$15.00 within the said period of ten (10) days, shall render such owner or operator subject to the filing of a citation with the District Justice and the fines and costs prescribed previously in this section.

Enforcement Officers are defined as individuals designated by Resolution of Borough Council, from time to time, as a parking law enforcement officer, and shall have the power to issue parking tickets and citations to enforce this Ordinance pursuant to the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, including Rule No. 401, as amended, from time to time.

SECTION 3. Section I, Definitions, is hereby amended by adding the following definition:

i. - The term vehicle shall include all of the following: truck, tractor, truck tractor trailer, truck tractor semi-trailer, a combination truck tractor and truck tractor trailer, semi-trailer, a truck classified by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, as amended, as a Class 4 or higher, a bus, camper, motor home and trailer.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this Ordinance revoke any and all portions of any ordinances inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 5. All provisions of Ordinance No. 88-4 shall remain in full force and effect except as amended hereby.
