

ORDINANCE NO. 99.03

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Turbotville, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE: The owner of every property fronting upon or alongside of any of the streets in the Borough of Turbotville is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from all of the sidewalks in front of or alongside of such street all snow or ice thereon fallen or formed within 24 hours after the same shall have ceased to fall or to form.

SECTION TWO: Any owner who shall fail to remove any snow or ice from any sidewalk as required by Section One of this ordinance shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$35 for the first offense in a six-month period, a fine of not more than \$50 for the second offense in a six-month period and a fine of not more than \$50 for each subsequent offense in a six-month period, plus costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to be imprisoned for a period not in excess of one day for each dollar in default, provided that such fine and costs of prosecution may be in addition to any expenses and additional amounts authorized by law.

SECTION THREE: For each offense under this ordinance, the appropriate enforcement official for the Borough of Turbotville shall be authorized to issue a ticket or notice for the amount of the prescribed fine for the offense and send the same to the person charged with violating this ordinance hereunder, by certified mail, to the address of the person or by personally

delivering said ticket or notice to the individual or by posting said ticket or notice on the door of the person's residence. If such ticketing procedure is used, the person charged with violating this article shall have a period of 10 days within which to pay said ticket or notice, and in the event that the individual fails to pay said ticket or notice, then the individual enforcing said ordinance shall file summary proceedings before a District Justice for the amount of the fine plus costs.

SECTION FOUR: Each day's continuance of any violation hereunder, after notice thereof by the Borough of Turbotville, shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION FIVE: All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
