

## ORDINANCE NO. 88-4

ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE PARKING  
OF CERTAIN VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS AND  
STREETS, ALLEYS, HIGHWAYS, ROADWAYS, OR WAYS IN  
THE BOROUGH OF TURBOTVILLE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THERETO

WHEREAS, the Borough of Turbotville is desirous of regulating the parking of certain vehicles in residential zones and on streets, alleys, highways, roadways, or ways in the Borough of Turbotville.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Borough of Turbotville, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section I. Definitions: The following words and phrases as used in this Ordinance shall have the following meanings:

- a. Park or parking - The halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except for the purpose of and while actually engaged, in loading or unloading passengers or personal property.
- b. Truck Tractor - A motor vehicle designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and the load so drawn.
- c. Truck Tractor Semi Trailer - A trailer so constructed that some part of its weight rests upon or is carried by a towing tractor.
- d. Truck Tractor Trailer - A vehicle designed to be towed by a truck tractor.
- e. Motor Home - A motor vehicle designed and used primarily for the purpose of a home while camping, traveling, or vacationing.
- f. Camper - A trailer designed and used primarily for the purpose of a home while camping, traveling, or vacationing, that can be towed by any vehicle.
- g. Bus - A motor vehicle designed and used primarily for the purpose of transporting and seating more than sixteen (16) persons.

h. Residential Zone - The current residential zoning classification pursuant to the Borough of Turbotville Zoning Ordinance No. 2-63, as amended.

Section II. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or coporation, or any agent thereof, to park a truck tractor, truck tractor trailer, truck tractor semi-trailer, combination truck tractor and truck tractor trailer, combination truck tractor and truck tractor semi-trailer or any truck classified by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code as amended, as Class 4 or higher, or any bus or any unlicensed vehicle, in a residential district or zone, as is designated in the Borough of Turbotville, in accordance with the Borough of Turbotville Zoning Ordinance, as amended.

Section III. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, or any agent thereof, to park a truck tractor, truck tractor trailer, truck tractor semi-trailer, a combination truck tractor and truck tractor trailer, a combination truck tractor and truck tractor trailer semi-trailer, a truck classified by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, as amended, as a Class 4 or higher, a bus, any unlicensed vehicle, camper or motor home on any streets, alleys, highways, roadways, or ways situate within the Borough of Turbotville.

Section IV. Penalties. Any person, firm, or corporation, or any agent thereof, who fails to comply with any or all of the provisions as set forth in Section II<sup>a</sup> of this Ordinance, as in violation of same, shall, upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars. In default of payment of the fine, such person, the members of such partnership, or the officers of such corporation, shall be liable to imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days. Each day that a violation is continued shall constitute a separate offense. All fines collected for the violation of this Section of the Ordinance shall be paid over to the Borough of Turbotville.

Any person, firm, or corporation, or agent thereof, who fails to comply with any or all provisions of Section ~~II~~<sup>III</sup>, or is in violation of same, shall be guilty of an offense, and upon conviction, shall pay a fine to the Borough of Turbotville of not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars and not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, plus costs of presecution. In default of such payment, such person shall undergo imprisonment in the Northumberland County Jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days. Each day's continuance

of the offense shall constitute a new offense and may be prosecuted accordingly.

Section V. All Ordinances of the Borough of Turbotville, which are in conflict or are inconsistent with the above are hereby repealed, insofar as they are in conflict or are inconsistent with the above Ordinance.
